

# Eagle Tickets

Student recognition for following the Eagle Way

Students and classrooms can receive “Eagle” tickets for following our Eagle Way.

- Any staff member can issue blue “Eagle” individual tickets or gold “Eagle” classroom tickets for those “caught being good.” If possible, teachers will write a brief description on the ticket explaining how a student or classroom earned a ticket.
- All individual and classroom “Eagle” tickets will be collected in the classroom. A monthly assembly will be held to celebrate good behavior. All earned tickets will be turned in with the hope of winning an exciting honor. Ten students will be given a poster-board to take home, decorate, individualize, and then placed on the main bulletin board in the hallway. These will be our “Eagle Students of the Month.” In addition, one classroom will win the rights to have the ultra-valuable crystal eagle trophy in their classroom till the next assembly.
- One lucky student will have a “Read” poster made and hung in a visible location in the school.
