

## **2H Classroom Expectations**

### **The Eagle Way--**

1. Be respectful.
2. Be responsible.
3. Be safe.

Responsibility and cooperation are the foundation on which the classroom rules are built. Skills in problem-solving, responsibility, and self-discipline are developed in our classroom through student involvement in meeting class expectations. The following plan is in effect for inappropriate behavior:

1. Three warnings (Verbal/visual)
2. Student develops an Eagle Flight Plan at recess
3. Eagle Flight Plan signed by parent
4. Parent/teacher communication

### **Caring School Community--**

Daily check-in meetings, team builder activities, and weekly class meetings are facilitated to enhance social emotional learning. This involves the students in conflict resolution developing higher-order thinking skills and encourages self-discipline and responsibility.

### **Talk-It-Out Corner--**

Individuals may be sent to the Talk-It-Out corner to resolve problems. Students are to use “I” statements to express their feelings and calmly reason with one another in a peaceful manner. Teacher guidance and input is provided as needed.
