Format:

Line 1: Choose a noun and write a sentence telling that you see the noun. (a noun is a person, place, or thing)

Line 2: Rewrite your first sentence, but add an adjective. (adjectives describe a noun)

Line 3: Rewrite your second sentence, but add a verb. (verbs are action words)

Line 4: Rewrite your third sentence, but add an adverb telling how the noun does the action. (adverbs have an -ly ending)

Line 5: Rewrite your fourth sentence, but include a prepositional phrase telling where the noun does the action. (a preposition tells where something is: on, in, around, next to, above, below, etc.)

Example:

I see a **clown**.

I see a **silly** clown.

I see a silly clown **juggling**.

I see a silly clown juggling **acrobatically**.

I see a silly clown juggling acrobatically **on an elephant's back**.
