### **First Grade**

*The first graders have just finished their first project of the year. They each completed a template self portrait and added details to make it look realistic.*

*This week we started learning about the color wheel. We've practiced mixing primary colors together to get secondary colors (green, orange, and purple). Next, we will create a color wheel still life picture using what we've learned about colors.*

### **Second Grade**

The first few weeks of school have been filled with buttons, paper mosaic pieces, yarn, felt, plastic jewels and lots of glue! We are finishing our collage self portraits! They look great!

In our next project we will integrate art with social studies and become mapmakers!

### **Fourth Grade**

*The fourth graders did another impressive job with their modern self portraits. Each student traced a copy of his/her photo to make the portrait look realistic. Then, we brainstormed adjectives that describe who we are, and added them to the background. Next week, the fourth graders will start their VanGogh unit.*

Then they designed a face using Picasso's cubist style and Crayola markers. Now, we are adding tissue paper squares to give the background a "broken glass" look. These projects are spectacular!
