

## **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Policy Regarding District Assessments**

### **1. Classroom specific information parents and students can expect to receive about district assessments.**

The grade 6 team will continue the same practices that have proved successful in past years for communicating information to parents about district assessments. All assessments will be reviewed in class and are available to the students upon request to take home and return. The return date is up to the discretion of the teacher.

### **2. Classroom specific information students will receive on procedures for further attempts.**

In accordance with the Board approved guidelines for Mastery of Learning, students may request a further attempt of a district assessment. In addition, a teacher may advise a student to do a further attempt. In all circumstances, the student will need to demonstrate extra preparation or study to earn a further attempt. The specifics of the preparation or study will be made clear to the student by the teacher. This process will be determined by a student/teacher meeting. Further attempts will not be allowed during class time.

### **3. Classroom specific information students will receive on how assessment results from original and further attempts will be communicated.**

The new score will show up as the actual score and the previous attempt score will be communicated in the comment section on Skyward Family Access. As such, parents can easily discern whether a score pertains to a first attempt or an original attempt.
