## Major Grammar Points You Need to Know!!!

### SUBJECT PRONOUNS (pronombres de sujeto):

SINGULAR	PLURAL
I=yo	we(m)=nosotros we(f)=nosotras
you(familiar/informal)=tú	y'all(familiar/informal/m)=vosotros y'all(familiar/informal/f)=vosotras (used in Spain)
he=él she=ella you(polite/formal)=usted Ud.	they(m)=ellos they(f)=ellas you all(polite/formal)=ustedes (used everywhere) Uds.

### VERBS (verbos):

<u>ser=to be</u>		<u>tener=to have</u>	
soy	somos	tengo	tenemos
eres	sois	tienes	tenéis
es	son	tiene	tienen

Asking where someone is from:

¿De dónde+SER+person?

Telling where someone is from:

Person+SER+de+place.

### ADJETIVOS (adjectives):

ADJECTIVES (describing words) come AFTER the noun they are describing.

el gato **blanco**      la estrella **amarilla**

ADJECTIVES (describing words) must match the noun they are describing in GENDER (masculino o femenina) and NUMBER (singular o plural).

**el** gato blanco      **los** gatos blancos  
**la** estrella amarilla      **las** estrellas amarillas
