

Homeside Activities

Homeside activities are 15-20 minute activities that are sent home once a month in order to add a “homeside” to the “schoolside” learning we are doing in class. These activities

- are built around conversations between you and your child
- deal with topics and ideas related to school
- and they help to create a partnership between home and school.

These activities also contribute to your child’s academic and social learning because

- they help you stay in touch with your child’s learning
- working with you helps to increase your child’s interest in the work
- your child gets to practice communication skills and think about important ideas
- and your child learns from you and sees how school relates to “real life.”
