Homework Policy

Homework is due at the beginning of Spanish; students may not return to classrooms to retrieve forgotten items, including homework. We are working on following "The Eagle Way: Be respectful, Be responsible, Be safe." Students are responsible for copying their homework in their assignment notebooks.

If a student does not have a homework assignment at the beginning of class, it is considered late. Students will have one day to make it up and turn it in. A late homework assignment will have 2 points automatically deducted. If the homework assignment is not turned in on the late day, it will be a zero, recorded on their classroom incentive sheets.

All students are responsible for having a Spanish folder with the inside pockets labeled with "keep in folder" and "take home." The "take home" side can be emptied often while the "keep in folder" side should not be emptied until the end of the year; these papers serve as a "resource" for students throughout the year.
